

THE SCALLOPED IPHONE CASE

Materials

for this project, you'll need the following:

- 8.5x11 inches of leather or felt
- Hammer
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Pattern
- iPhone
- Leather punch or awl
- Waxed linen thread or sinew
- Needle

Directions

Smooth out the leather on a table or self-healing mat.

Lay the pattern pieces on the leather, trace & cut as carefully as possible.

Using the line guides from the large pattern piece, line up the three pattern pieces and tape each piece together with clear packing tape or scotch tape. Tape the large pattern piece to the leather.

Using a hammer and leather punch, punch holes in the leather. Use the dots on the pattern piece as your hole punch guide.

Remove the pattern piece and tape. Thread the needle with waxed thread or artificial sinew.

To start sewing, thread needle in between the two layers and leave a 2-3 inch tail. Weave in and out of holes, then double back to your starting point.


Once you've sewn all the way around the leather and you're heading back to your starting point, thread the needle between the two layers (your starting point) and tie a square knot. You don't have to have the knot in the middle of the two layers, but this is good for keeping the knot hidden. Trim ends.

Insert iPhone or iPod touch. Enjoy.























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
